4) Executive Reports

a) President's Report: James

- i. Student Initiatives Update
 - Wanted to update general council on what the committee has approved

 - Comments:
 - o Are they required to submit receipts? → Yes, it is done as a reimbursement by finance
- ii. HPRAC Petition
 - This petition has been put together by a student in 1T1
 - Thanks to everyone for replying to the emails so quickly
 - 2/3 of council replied and said they supported it and no one said that they did not support it so James went ahead with allowing the use of the logo
 - Comments:
 - Concern that it was just our logo vs. a University of Waterloo University (nice) logo
 - o Do we want a new logo? → seems that the general consensus of council is that we do
 - o Yvonne says to see Jeff Eiken (Communications) and he will help with a redesign of the logo → James is comfortable doing this
 - Last year we talked about changing the name of UPS too should we combine that with the logo redesign? → decided to do another year (not at same time as referendum and we are also still waiting to see if entry level PharmD goes through)

- i. GenPharm Raffle update

- ii. Elections timeline
 - Everything is divided into sections
 - *Interview positions* (external, yearbook, monograph, webmaster)
 - These are going to take place one week earlier than last year due to the timing of reading week
 - o Jan.26th → call for nominations for UPS positions requiring an interview
 - Current members holding positions must send 2 listservs and make an announcement to the 1T0s and 1T1
 - Members currently holding the position can set what they require in terms of an application
 - o Feb 1st \rightarrow deadline for applications
 - o Feb. 2nd-6th: interviews
 - o Feb. 9th-13th: selection of successful candidates
 - if for some reason interviews were not done the week before they can be done here as long as the position is filled and candidates are informed by the 13th
 - o Feb. 23rd at 5pm → UPS meeting to vote on the approval of the successful candidates
