William:

However, due to limitations of being a new club/committee, we were unable to accomplish certain Advocacy Initiatives during the school year. I feel that UPS does a great job in promoting student life, but it lacks an interest in promoting for our profession. Especially during this critical time when our profession is undergoing great change, I feel that having UPS Council Positions for the purposes of advocacy will ensure the presence of a student voice for our profession. If you guys are open to the idea, then we can find sometime to talk about it. Adam and I will be in charge of SOAPE next year and we do not mind setting up these positions for the future constitution review. As of now, we have nothing solid in place, but there is high potential for this, then we will work on it during the summer."

Marko: SOAPE can apply for funding through the Student Initiatives Fund. Can create a SOAPE subcommittee on UPS for next year and can have the OPA Student member to sit on it to act as a liaison between the OPA and SOAPE.
