  - Finance Directors will meet with bookkeeper (Ian) to get him up to date on the UPS financial situation and the tasks at hand.
  - Estimated that it may be ~2 months timeline to complete audits if everything goes well.
  - Smaller reimbursements will be processed soon; larger reimbursements will be processed once student fees are released from UofT Central Office (i.e. Office of the Vice-Provost, Students).
  - Goal for Finance department: To set up this system so it is running smoothly for this and all subsequent years, before the current Council goes off duty.
