- i. **Motion re. grad fund allocation:** To allocate an amount of \$12,180.22, from the Grad Fund interest money from the Advancement Office given to UPS, to the Class of 2T3 for supporting the class's graduation efforts.
 - 1. Rationale in support:
 - a. This allocation will not impact the financial capacities of the UPS in any way, since its use is strictly for support graduation efforts, its transactions are kept in a separate ledger in the Budget, and its use for





- any other purpose will contravene our agreements with the LDFP and the donor.
- b. There is no predictable timeline on the progress of the audits, leaving it an uncertain question whether the Class of 2T3 will receive their portion of grad fund in a timely manner for their grad effort planning.
- The Class of 2T3 is the most severely impacted during the pandemic, yet the only class at LDFP yet to have received a subsidy from the UPS.
 It is a logical move to allocate this grad-specific fund to this class for this grad-specific purpose.
